Dear Resident:

The Miami County Board of Commissioners and the Miami County Sanitary Engineer are working together to secure grant and low interest loan funding to provide a sanitary sewer and water system for your neighborhood. **We need your help.**

In order for Miami County to qualify the project area for grant and loan funding, the County needs to undertake an Income Survey of all the households located within the project area. The information requested in the Income Survey will remain confidential.

Beginning as early as July 26th, and over the next several weeks, I will be contacting you and asking you to complete a survey form. The actual survey document is included with this letter. We can fill out the survey document together when I visit your household or you can simply fill out the form on your own and present it to me when I visit your residence.

There are two items of information included on each survey: 1) The total number of persons living in your home on a year-round basis; and 2) The total income of each person 18 years old or older living in your home. The income information can be either your current income or the amount of income you earned in 2009. If your projected income for 2010 is going to be lower than it was in 2009, we would prefer that information as it will help make the survey more accurate and further help qualify the area for grant funding.
